As the organising authority in association with Australian Sailing, we invite entries in the 2022 Pulse Credit Union Catamaran Challenge.

A 20 to 30 nautical mile event for OTB catamarans will be conducted on the waters of Lake Victoria at Loch Sport on Saturday 29th of October 2022

1. RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

2.1 The event is open to all off the beach catamaran classes with an Australian Sailing yardstick (whether classified as “primary or otherwise “)

2.2 The helms person, and when appropriate the crew, shall:

- be members of a club affiliated with Australian Sailing or its equivalent in another State or Territory and be a current Australia Sailing Silver Member.
- Shall not be changed without prior approval of the Race Committee. Such approval shall only be considered if the application is in writing and a valid reason is given.

2.3 Eligible boats may enter on the Entry Form which shall be lodged at the Loch Sport Boat Club registration desk, accompanied by the required fee between 0900 and 1100 hours on Saturday 29th of October 2022

2.4 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee.

3. FEES

3.1 Required fees: \$ 20.00 per Boat.

4. EVENT SCHEDULE

41 Saturday 4th of December 2021

42 Registration 0930 – 1200 hours

Information session 1200 hours

Warning signal 1255 hours

4.2 If there are sufficient entries of a class the race committee may create a separate division for that class, otherwise all boats start together.

5. MEASUREMENTS.

Measurement is not required but each boat shall submit proof of holding a valid measurement certificate if requested by the Race Committee.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 0930 on Saturday the 29th of October 2022 at the Loch Sport Boat Club registration desk.

8. COURSE

The course shall be as described at the information session.

Presentation will be held as soon as possible after the Race. Prizes will be awarded to the overall winner and place getters in each division depending on the number of entries.
